



COVID 19 Preventative Measures for the Teams, Staff and Volunteers attending the FIS Europa Cup in Åre Duved

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic has affected every aspect of live for both business and individuals worldwide. The Swedish Ski Federation, FIS and Åre's LOC are happy that this year welcome you all back to the FIS Europa Cup competitions.

The **FIS Europa Cup** in Åre **Duved from January 29 – 30 2021** will take place with enhanced safety measures. Based on the current directive by the Swedish Ministry for Health and exceeding measures by Åre as well as by FIS, we herewith send this measure catalogue to you all. By by receiving the accreditation and entering the competition every individual accepts the content of this measure catalogue entirely.

Basics

- Individual Responsibility
- Hygiene measure (frequent handwashing, frequent disinfection)
- Minimum distance of one meter everywhere

Mouth- nose protection

- In Sweden there is no law or recommendation to wear mouth nose protection but of course individuals are free to wear their mouth nose protection!
- Staff that are close to the teams and or each other will be wearing mouth-nose protection.

Journey to Åre

- Do not travel to the venue with symptoms of COVID-19
- If people close to you have been affected with COVID-19, please contact your superior and refrain from travelling to the event.
- Avoid stops when travelling to the venue
- Avoid contact with other people especially team members.

Accreditation

- Due to the present situation we as organizers must limit the number of accredited persons. Please accredit only persons that are really working during the FIS race.
- Only one representative may collect all accreditations for their team or service providers. BIB will work as accreditation for athletes
- For FIS official and Media personnel they will receive their accreditation at the hotel where they will stay
- Employees of the accreditation/race office wear mouth nose protection

Event Venue

• Keep minimum one meter distance!





- Stay only in the allocated and marked zones.
- For service providers and media: Please avoid direct contact to sports teams and wear mouth-nose protection. As well as avoid contact with other staff members and members of the press.
- When riding in the chair lift all persons must be of the same team or same working group.

Race office

• Keep minimum two meter distance!

COVID – 19 communication

- In case of symptoms inform the LOC as well as your supervisor immediately.
- LOC and Skistar will activate COVID- 19 chain of measures.
- In case of symptoms there is isolation rooms available
- All communication concerning COVID-19 must be discussed and agreed with FIS and the LOC.
- Åre Covid 19 coordinator,
- LOC Covid 19 coordinator
- Event doctor

To minimize the risk of infection the LOC recommends

- Small groups
- Limit contact to other persons
- Avoid contact with tourists/fans
- Spend your free time only with members of your team/group.
